

Town of Middleton Park Use Rules

Town of Middleton Parks are designed for the enjoyment of all Town Residents and their guests. Park Users are reminded that the following rules and policies apply to all Town park and recreation properties.

PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

Pets Including Dogs and Horses*
All Firearms/Bows/Weapons
Motorized/Radio Controlled Aircraft
Overnight Camping

Motorized Vehicles
Hunting or Trapping
Snowmobiles, ATV's & Motorcycles
Golf or Golf Practice is Not Allowed

*Pets are only allowed in parks designated for dogs, Tallard Conservancy, and must be on a leash. Horses are allowed on marked horse trails.

Special Notices

Park in designated areas only
Dog Manure must be removed from
parks, roads and trails

Use of Sound Systems *Requires a Permit*
Vending *Requires a Permit*

Cautions!

Bare feet may result in injury!
Stay clear of moving play equipment!
Do not run on play equipment!

Play equipment slippery when wet!
Do not throw sand or objects!
Do not push or shove others!

Park Shelters

Park Shelters are available in many of the Town Parks on a first-come/first serve basis. Park shelters may be reserved for a nominal charge. Reservation forms are available at the Town Hall. Shelters and Park Areas must be left in a clean condition as a requirement and a courtesy to the next group.

Park Hours

Town of Middleton Parks are open from 6:00 am to 10:00 pm daily.
Town of Middleton Conservancies are open from dawn to dusk (considered to be
½ hour before sunrise and sunset)
