NOXIOUS WEED NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to each and every person who owns, occupies, or controls land in the TOWN OF MIDDLETON, County of Dane, State of Wisconsin, to cut or destroy noxious weeds on such property before the plants bloom.

Noxious weeds include but are not limited to:

- Canada Thistle
- Leafy Spurge
- Field Bindweed (creeping Jenny)
- Yellow Rocket
- Perennial Sow Thistle
- Musk Thistle
- Giant Foxtail
- Wild Hemp (Marijuana)
- Garlic Mustard
- Velvet Leaf
- Wild Radish
- Bull Thistle
- Buckthorn Bush
- Any other weed the governing body of any municipality or the county board of any county by ordinance or resolution declares to be noxious within its respective boundaries.

Noxious Weeds must be destroyed at such time and in such manner as shall effectively prevent them from bearing seed or spreading to adjoining properties as required by Wis. Stats. § 66.0407 and Middleton Town Code of Ordinances § 12.02(3).
