



Park Use Rules for all Town Park and Recreation Properties:

PROHIBITED ITEMS AND ACTIVITIES:

Pets Including Dogs and Horses*	Motorized Vehicles
All Firearms/Bows/Weapons	Hunting or Trapping
Motorized/Radio Controlled Aircraft	Snowmobiles, ATV's & Motorcycles
Overnight Camping	Golf or Golf Practice is Not Allowed

*Dogs are only allowed in parks designated for dogs, and at Tallard Conservancy, and must be on a leash at all times.

*Horses are allowed on marked horse trails.

Special Notices

Park in designated areas only	Use of Sound Systems <i>Requires a Permit</i>
Dog manure must be removed from parks, roads and trails	Vending <i>Requires a Permit</i>

Park Shelters

Park Shelters are available in many of the Town Parks on a first-come/first serve basis. Park shelters may be reserved for a nominal charge. Reservation forms are available at the Town Hall. Shelters and Park Areas must be left in a clean condition by requirement and as a courtesy to the next group.

Park Hours

Town of Middleton Parks are open from 6:00 am to 10:00 pm daily.
Town of Middleton Conservancies are open from dawn to dusk (considered to be
½ hour before sunrise and sunset)
